Ham and Noodle Casserole

4 cups uncooked egg noodles

2 cups diced cooked ham

2 cups shredded Swiss cheese

1 (10.5 ounce) can condensed cream of chicken soup

1 onion, finely chopped

½ cup sour cream

salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste

¼ cup dry bread crumbs

Gather all ingredients. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. Grease a 2-quart casserole. Fill a large pot with lightly salted water and bring to a rapid boil. Cook egg noodles in the boiling water for 3 minutes, stirring

occasionally. Remove from the heat, cover, and let stand until tender, about 10 minutes. Drain.

Transfer noodles to a large bowl; stir in ham, Swiss cheese, condensed soup, onion, and sour cream. Season with salt and pepper. Spoon into the prepared casserole dish and sprinkle bread crumbs over the top. Bake in the preheated oven until casserole is bubbling and bread crumbs are browned, about 40 minutes.



Apple Salad

2 Honeycrisp apples, cored and chopped

2 celery stalks, chopped

1 cup red grapes, halved

½ cup pecans, chopped

½ cup dried cranberries

¼ cup mayonnaise

2 Tablespoons honey

1 Tablespoon lemon juice

Salt and pepper to taste

Combine ingredients: In a large bowl, combine the chopped apples, celery, grapes, pecans and dried cranberries. Make dressing: In a small bowl, whisk together the mayonnaise, honey, lemon juice, salt and pepper.

Toss salad: Pour the dressing over the salad and toss to coat evenly. Serve immediately or refrigerate for later.


