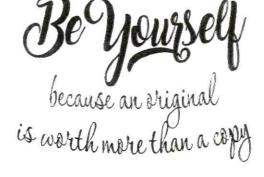

6. IT'S ON YOU

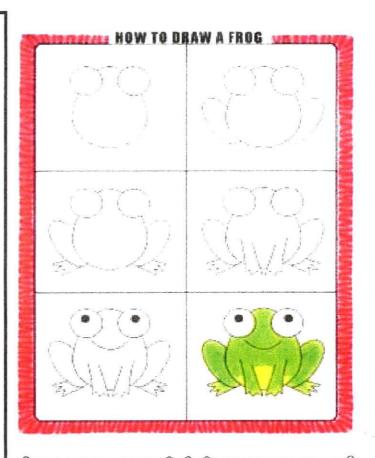

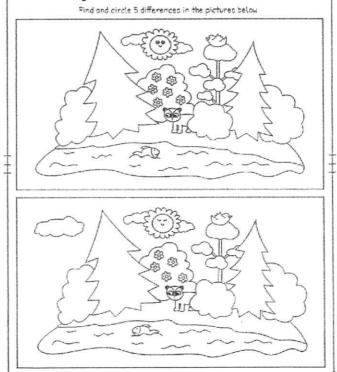

What's Cooking?

Simple Calbage Salad

2 tablespoons lemon juice

2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil

2 tablespoons chopped fresh flat-leaf parsley

1 tablespoon Dijon mustard

1 tablespoon honey

1 teaspoon garlic powder

½ teaspoon salt

½ teaspoon ground pepper

8 cups shredded green cabbage (from 1 small head)

Whisk lemon juice, oil, parsley, mustard, honey, garlic powder, salt and pepper together in a large bowl. Add cabbage and toss to coat; let stand for 10 minutes. Toss again; serve immediately or refrigerate for up to 1 hour before serving.



Bacon Pea Salad

4 slices bacon

34 cup mayonnaise

1 Tablespoon honey 1 Tablespoon white sugar

Salt and pepper to taste

1 (20 ounce) package fresh green peas

2 ribs celery

½ cup cubed cheddar cheese

1/3 cup onion

Place bacon in a large skillet and cook over medium-high heat, turning occasionally, until evenly browned. Drain bacon on paper towels and crumble. Reserve 1 Tablespoon bacon grease.

Whisk mayonnaise, reserved bacon grease, honey, sugar, salt and black pepper together in a bowl until dressing is smooth.

Mix bacon, peas, celery, cheddar cheese and onion together in a bowl. Drizzle dressing over salal and toss to coat.



S'mores Dip

1 Tablespoon butter

1 bag (12 oz.) milk or semisweet chocolate chips

7 oz. regular marshmallows (about 30) Graham crackers for dipping

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Place an 8-inch round cake pan in the oven to warm.

Remove the warm pan from the oven. Put the butter in the pan and swirl to coat the bottom. When the butter is melted, add the chocolate chips in an even layer. Top the chocolate chips with the marshmallows in an even layer.

Bake until the chocolate is melted, and the marshmallows are lightly golden brown, about 12 minutes.

Serve right away with the graham crackers for dipping.

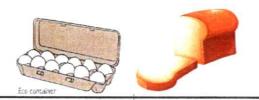
I took a job as the head of Old McDonald's farm.

I named my dog 6 Miles. That way I can tell everybody, "I walk 6 Miles every day."

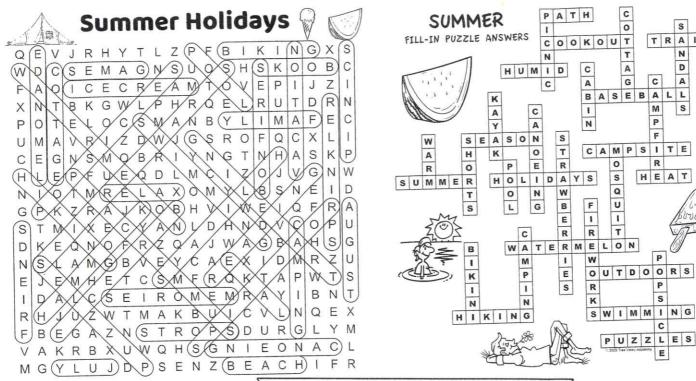

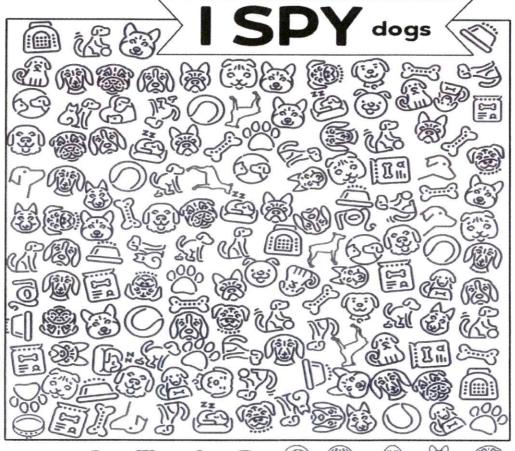

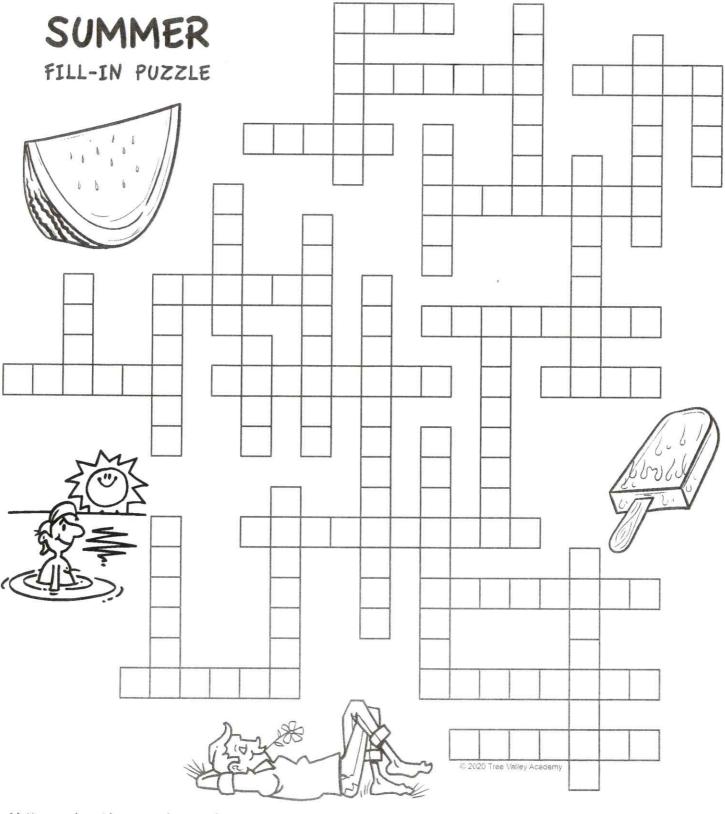
