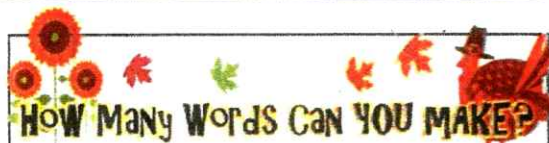

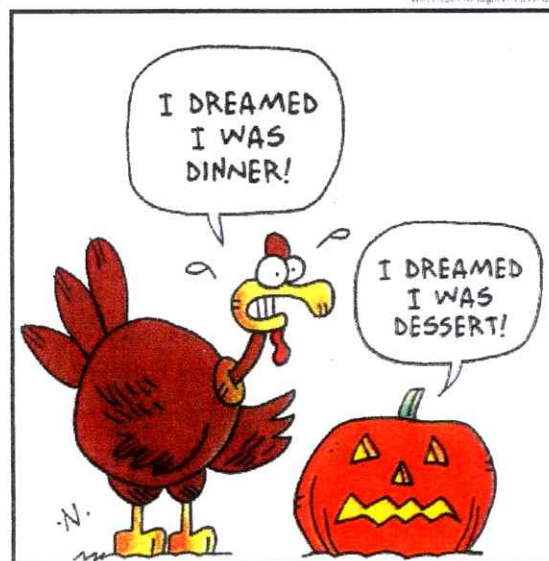
Veterans Day

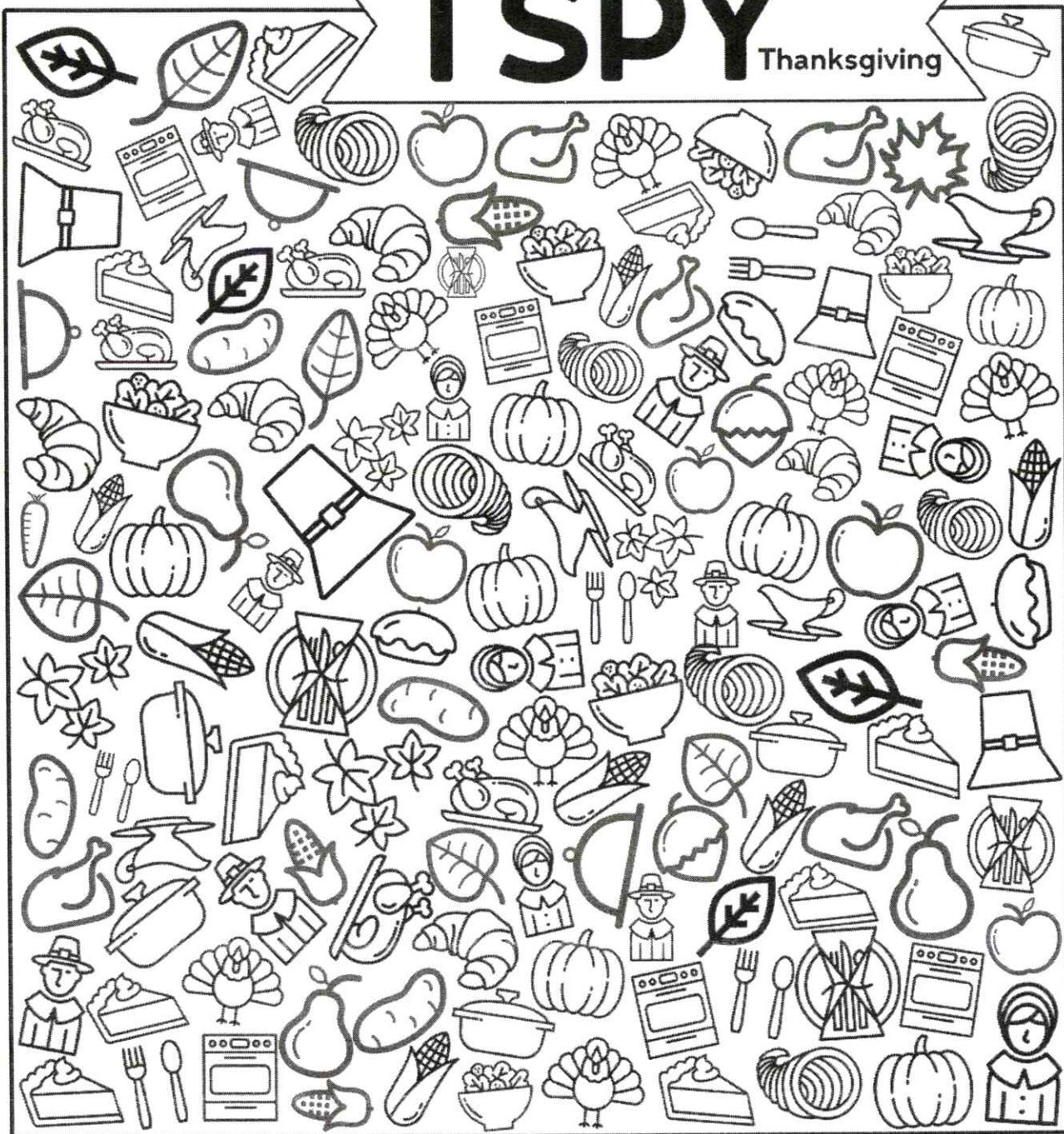
